TRIP EXPECTATIONS

- Will stay in assigned rooms & bus/plane seats unless given permission by lead chaperone.
- Will clean up after myself on the bus, plane & in my room. All garbage must be in garbage cans or neatly near cans if full.
- Will stay in groups of at least 3 when not with the whole group.
- Will spend my money wisely, considering the needs of the whole 6 days.
- Will be responsible for my outfit (stored in a garment bag) & baggage throughout the trip.

In the Hotel:

1. Boys in boy's rooms ONLY: girls in girl's rooms ONLY!!
2. Outgoing calls, paid TV movies, & other incidental charges are not accessible to the room. Phones are available in the lobby for long distance calls.
